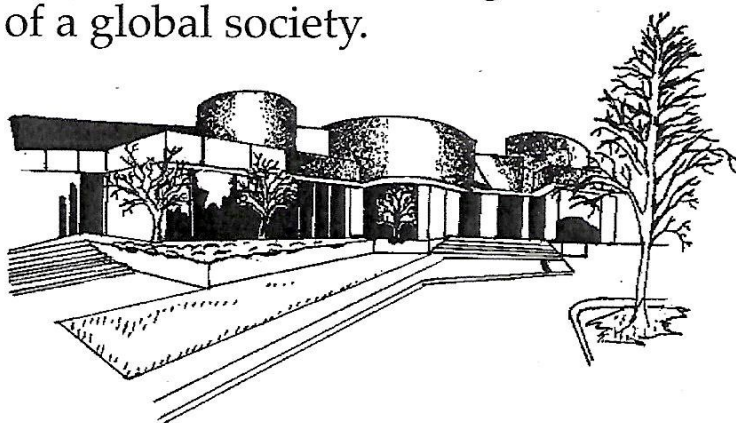

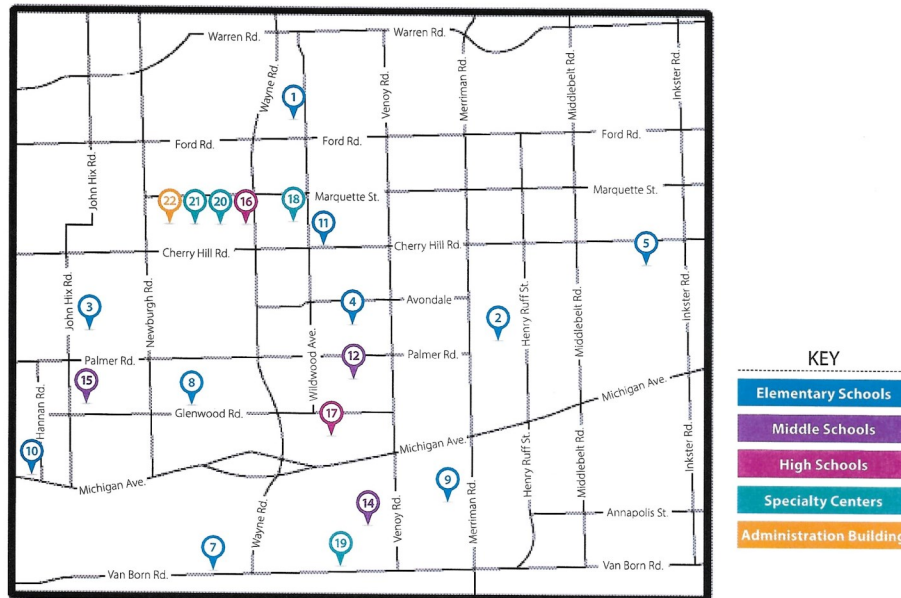

LONG TERM CARE PLANNING

Did you know that 50% of persons 65 years of age or older will spend some time in a nursing home, and that the average monthly cost of nursing home care in Michigan is \$6,191.00? Since neither health insurance nor Medicare pay for such care, it is no wonder that people fear losing their life savings to long term care costs. This course covers options to help pay for such care costs, the significant changes made to the Medicare rules in 2007, as well as the new "Estate Recovery" law, whereby the state can seek repayment from a person's estate for benefits paid, and ways to prevent that from happening. The course is taught by attorneys from Estate Planning Services, P.C., who are members of the Elder Law Section of the State Bar of Michigan and National Academy of Elder Law Attorneys.
