The safety and security of our students is our number one priority. Behaviors outlined in our district code of conduct will be fully enforced. Violation of our expectations can result in the loss of bus riding privileges for up to one full school year.

We expect:

- Students to get on and off the bus quickly and quietly.
- Students to remain seated for the entire journey.
- Students to keep their hands, feet and objects to themselves.
- Students to refrain from eating and drinking on our buses.
- Students to wait in a safe place, clear of traffic and away from where the bus stops.
- Students to conduct themselves in an orderly manner.
- Students to listen to the authority figure on the bus at all times.

Thank you for your support in helping us reinforce our expectations with your student(s). In the event your student violates our bus expectations, expect full implementation of our consequences that can lead up to expulsion from our district.
